
We provide EMS and Fire Service to the City of Moscow, Rural Fire District and Latah County

## POSITION DETAILS

- Provide emergency services to the citizens of Moscow, ID as a trained firefighter. EMT is optional, but encouraged. All training provided!
- Complete Fire I Academy
- Complete Driver/Operator Training
- Cover shift every 5 days
  - 1630-0730 weekdays
  - 0730-0730 weekends
  - Residents are relieved of duties during school breaks
- New residents must report for move-in and Rookie Training Academy on **Sunday August 2nd, 2026**



## REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 18 years old at the start of Fire Academy in August of 2026
- High school graduate or equivalent by the start of the program
- Possess valid driver's license and be insurable by MVFD
- Be enrolled in 12 or more credits at a academic institution for the 2026/2027 academic year, and maintain a 2.5 or higher GPA.



## BENEFITS

- Housing provided in college dorms at fire stations (meets University of Idaho "on campus" housing requirement)
- Training opportunities and continuing education including;
  - IFSAC Firefighter 1 & 2
  - Hazmat Operations
  - Driver-Operator
  - EMT and Paramedic
  - Extrication, Rescue and so much more...
- Leadership and professional development
- Community, friendships and fire service family

- Successfully pass driving and criminal history background check.
- Attend in person interview panel on **March 28th, 2026** in Moscow, ID
- Successfully pass the MVFD Physical Abilities Test (PAT) - video and details are online.

9. Teamwork often means stepping up when others are struggling. If you noticed a fellow volunteer having difficulty keeping up with training, what would you do?

Volunteers are required to participate in monthly meetings and training in addition to shift coverage. The work can be physically demanding and emotionally challenging. It is often a thankless job with few tangible rewards and significant training and participation requirements. For all our members, the rewards of serving our community and helping those in need motivate us to volunteer.
